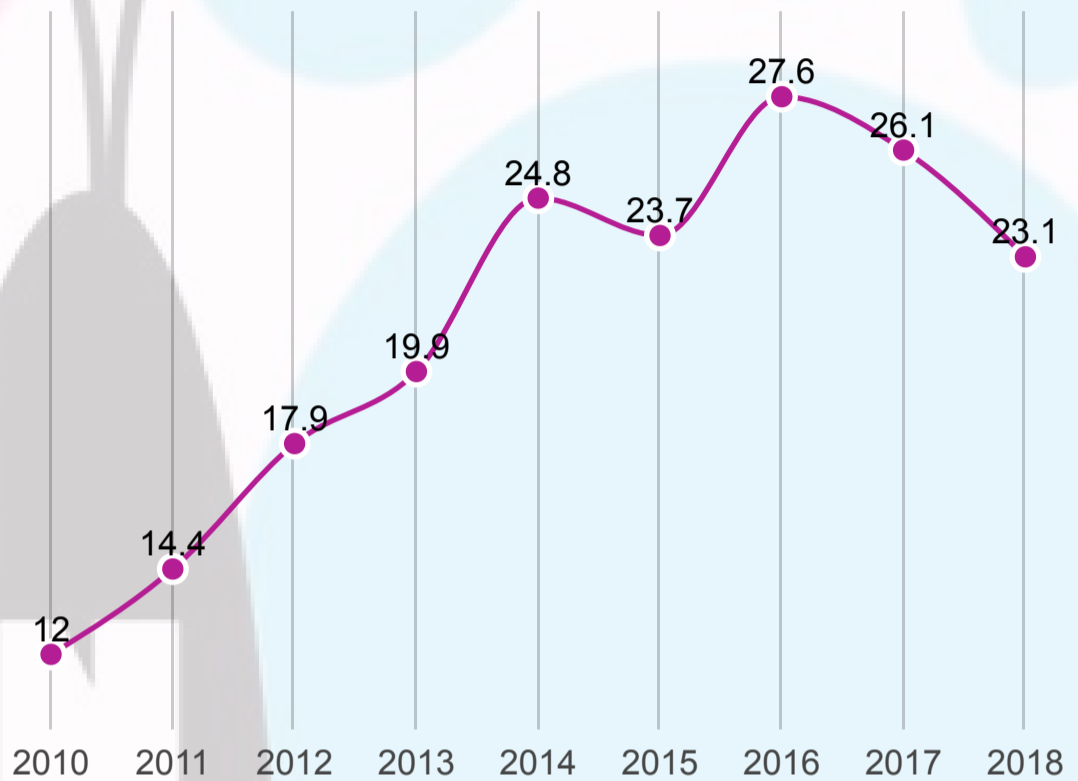

## ★ NEONATAL ABSTINENCE SYNDROME (NAS)

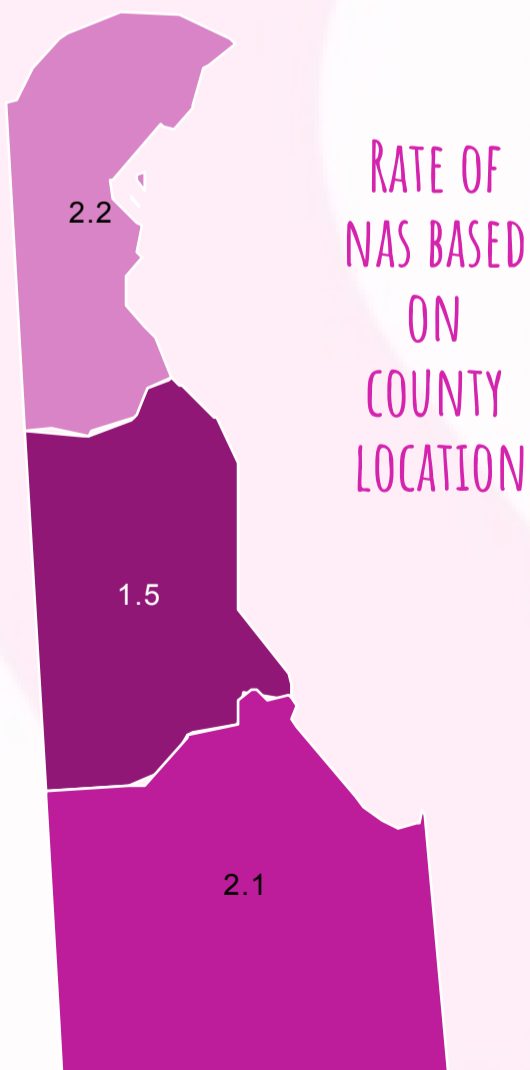
NAS is a withdrawal syndrome in newborns following birth that is primarily caused by maternal opiate use during the prenatal period.

## ▲ HOW ARE WE DOING?

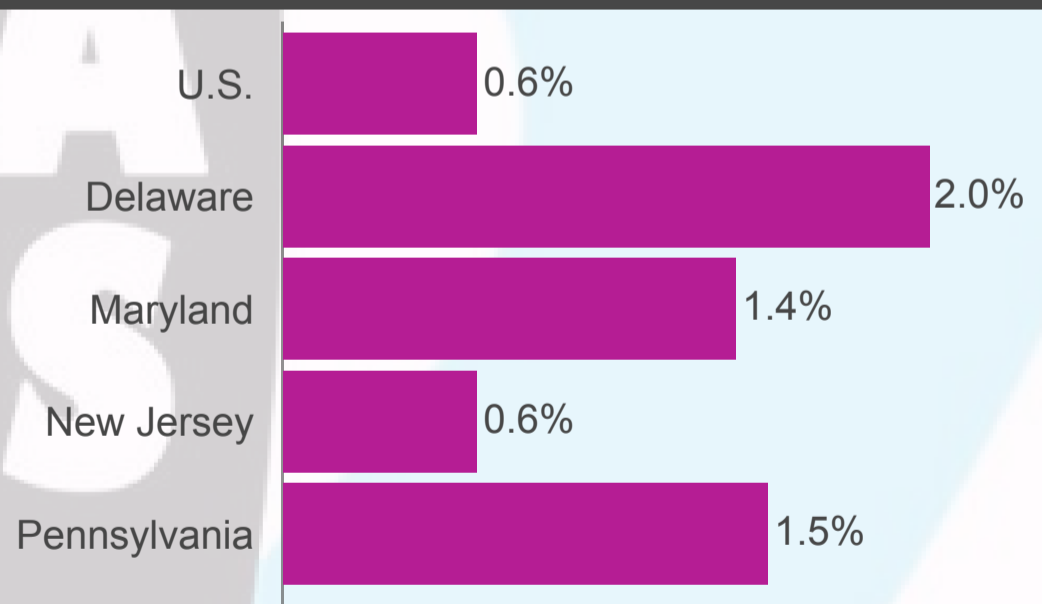
There were 1,956 cases of NAS identified in Delaware during 2010-2018. There was a 92% increase in NAS during 2010-2018.

## 👍 SIGNIFICANCE

The overall median charges billed for a NAS newborn during 2010-2018 after accounting for prematurity status was approximately \$20,000 with an overall median length of stay of 17 days
