Review of Previous Discussions:

Menu of Services:

Services determined by community need assessment, school district, school nurses, community providers

- ▶ Sports physicals
- ▶ Well child visits for those in need
- ▶ Minor acute care
- ▶ Immunizations
- ▶ Reproductive Health (middle & high)
- ▶ **LGBTQ+ Health?**
 - ▶ **Hormone Therapy**
 - ▶ **Pre-exposure prophylaxis**
- ▶ Behavioral Health
 - ▶ Psychiatry
 - ▶ Substance use counseling
- ▶ Nutrition Counseling
- ▶ Vision and Hearing Services
- ▶ Oral Health
- ▶ Health Education
- ▶ Social Services (insurance, food, housing, income, energy) especially in elementary and middle

Hours of Operation:

- ▶ August - June, limited July hours at Hub
- ▶ No weekend hours
- ▶ Office hours: 9 AM - 5 PM (or last bus)
 - ▶ Once a week until 8 PM at Hub
 - ▶ Depending on SD building staff/if Hub has external entrance, could have hours during school closures

Model Design:

- ▶ Hub and Spoke Model with siting dictated by school districts
- ▶ Not a medical home (unless necessary), connects kids to a medical home and incorporated into Pediatricians' care practice
 - ▶ Ask about PCP on enrollment forms
- ▶ No full family enrollment, but siblings enrolled in district can receive services at SBWC that is not their school (through hub and spoke)

SBWC Siting:

- ▶ Title I status, free and reduced meal numbers, insurance breakdown, poverty thresholds, volume of IEPs, availability of family care and private practice providers
- ▶ Costs associated with siting/construction

Draft Recommendations

 - ▶ NP/PA, RD, licensed mental health counselor, Medical Assistant
 - ▶ Base+ model with potential outside contractors as (+)
 - ▶ Community dental health coordinator (dental social worker), dental hygienist does work
 - ▶ CA virtual dental home model
- ▶ How and by whom should the staffing model be determined?
- ▶ What partnerships within the school should be made for SBWC staffing?
 - ▶ Integrating the school nurse and guidance counselor in core team (would refer to SBWC)
 - ▶ Can consult with SBWCs but no treatment for those not enrolled
- ▶ What outside partnerships should be made for SBWC staffing and service delivery?
 - ▶ Potential outside contractors for additional services
- ▶ How and by whom should personnel roles/scope be defined?
- ▶ How should SBWCs incorporate telehealth into SBWC staffing models?
 - ▶ Dental hygienist can data collect in schools and then dentist can provide guidance
