

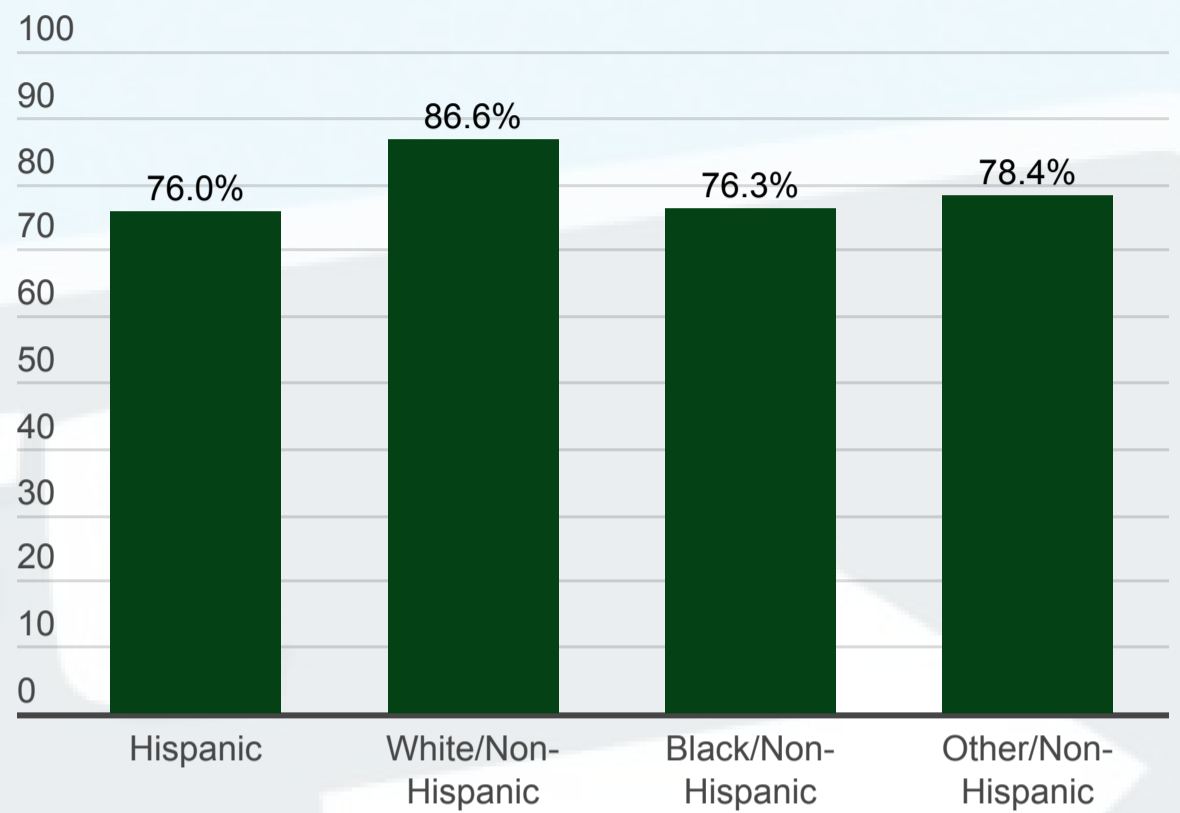

★ RACE/ETHNICITY DISPARITIES

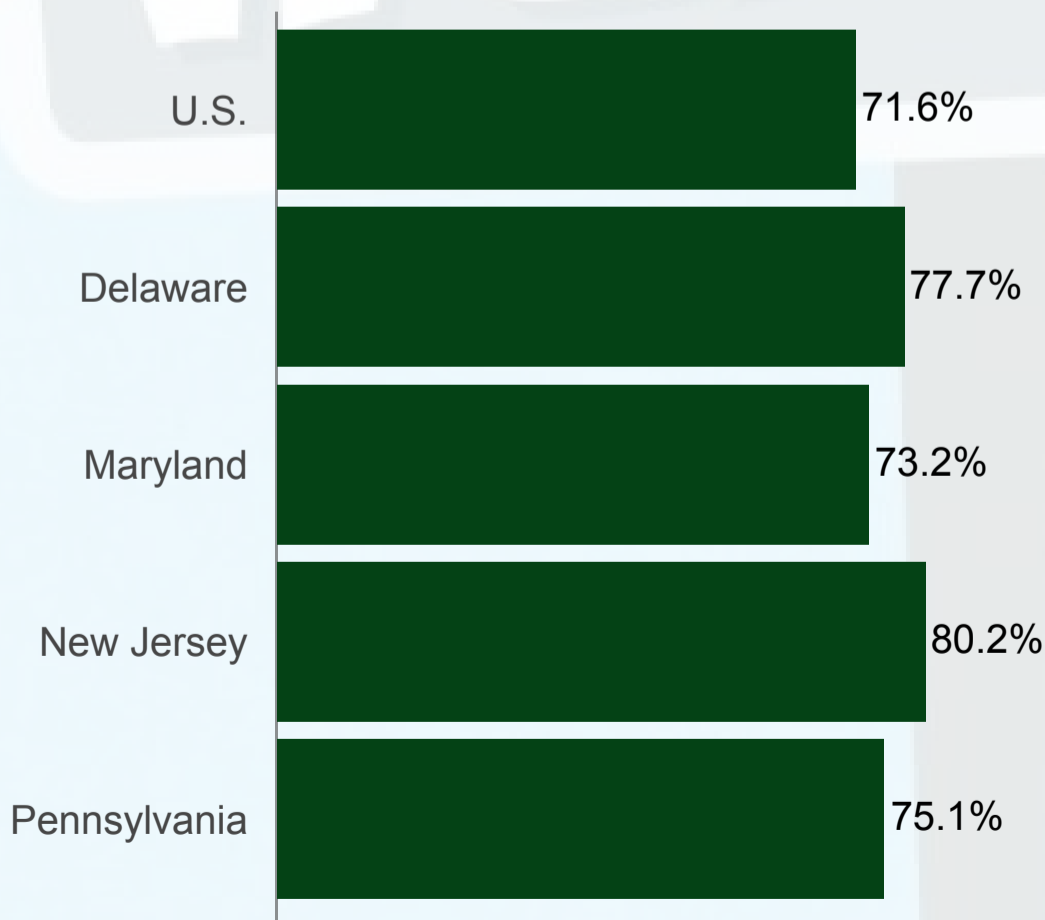
According to the 2017/2018 National Survey of Children's Health, 24.0% of Hispanic adolescents and 23.7% of Black adolescents did not obtain a preventive medical visit last year.

This is significantly higher compared to 13.4% of White adolescents who did not obtain a preventive medical visit.

▲ HOW ARE WE DOING?

According to the 2017/2018 National Survey of Children's Health, 22.3% of Delaware adolescents did not obtain a preventive medical visit last year, which is slightly better than the national average of 28.4%.

👍 DELAWARE'S ACTIVE MEASURES

Increasing the number of adolescents receiving a preventive well-visit annually to support their social, emotional and physical well-being is one of Delaware's currently selected National Performance Measures (NPM) for the 2021 fiscal year.

Develop a cross-system partnership and protocols to increase the proportion of adolescents receiving annual preventive services.

Increase the number of adolescents, ages 12 through 17, with a preventive medical visit in the past year.

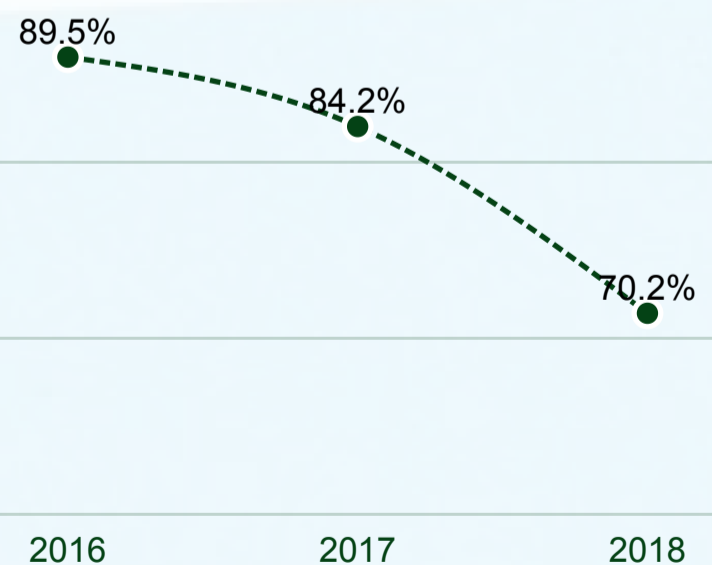
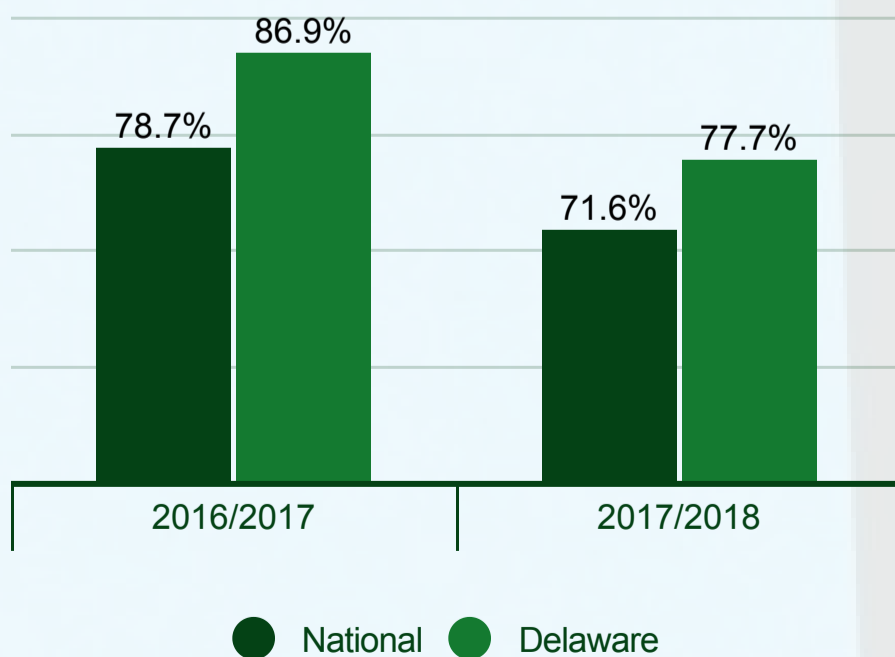
